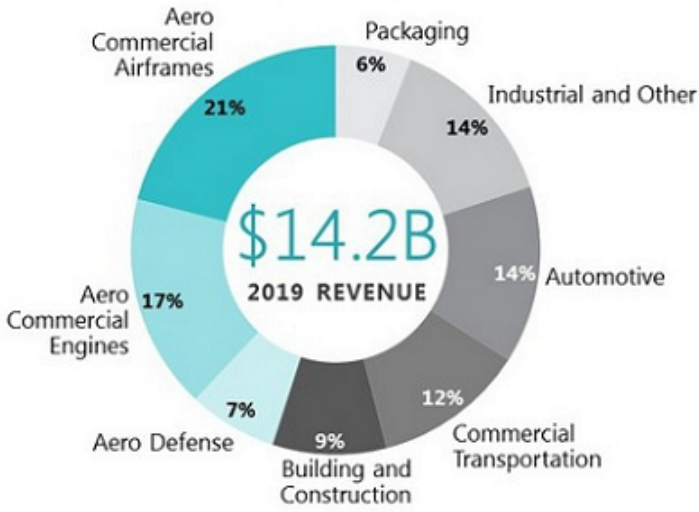

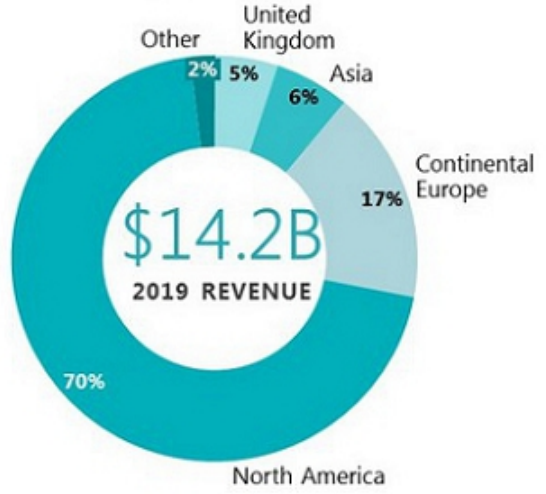

(% of total)

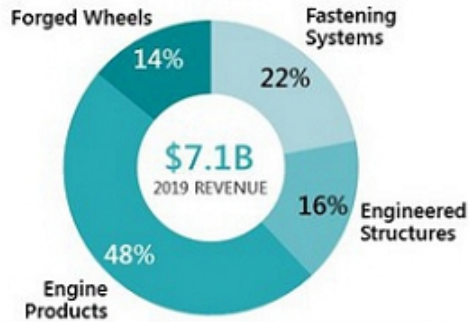


2019 Revenue by Region

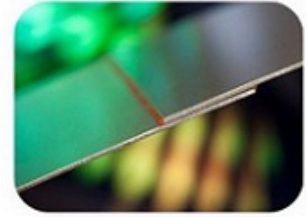

Global Rolled Products (GRP): Strong position in growing markets

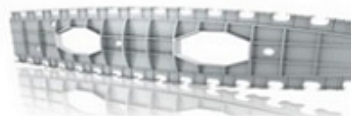
2019 Revenue by End-Market
